The Milton Ulladulla ExServos Club have been a supporter and sponosor of the Kokoda Youth Leadership Challenge (KYLC) for many years and are proud to sponsor exceptional Year 11 students each year from Ulladulla High School to partake in the trek.

Each year students from Ulladulla High School History class are offered the opportunity to enter by writing an essay explaining why they would like to complete the Kokoda Trek. Those short listed then present a speech to an interview panel on how taking the trek would benefit them personally.

This year the Club decided to send 4 lucky students and the winners were announced at the High School Anzac Day Commemoration Celebration. The award was also proudly renamed to commemorate our ex-president Brian Wilkins and is now proudly known as the 'Brian Wilkins KYLC Award'.

The challenge includes a strenuous 10-day trek across the original Kokoda trail in Papua New Guinea, following the path of the diggers who sacrificed their lives for us.

The Youth Leadership Challenge creates a greater awareness of these sacrifices and provides a deep insight into the challenges faced by the diggers.

The Kokoda Trek is physically demanding and not only provides the students with an indepth view into the experiences of the diggers, but helps develop and nuture leadership skills that translate back into the community.

We recently caught up with the 2023 trekkers and it was inspiring to hear their stories about this life changing experience. They also presented a hand crafted timber stick made by local Papua New Guinea people to the Club Board of Directors as a thank you for giving them this opportunity. This will take pride of place in our glass Anzac Memorial cabinet in the Club.

We would also like to thank the Ulladulla High School and the RSL Sub-branch for their continued support of this great award and wonderful opportunity for our local young leaders.

You may not know this, but your local community Club, the Milton Ulladulla ExServos Club, has implemented many small and large environmentally conscious changes to lessen our footprint over the years. We are dedicated to reducing our carbon footprint and limit waste production.

We love doing our bit for the environment

WHAT DO WE DO!

Solar Photovoltaic System: The Club installed 581 Enphase AC micro inverters, fire safe system equipped solar panels on our rooftop, each producing 370 watts, making it one of the largest rooftop systems in the southern hemisphere and saving 5,000 trees and 274,000kg of CO2 so far.

Food Waste: The Club donates our food waste to Little Forest Road, an initiative aiming for zero organic waste in our local community. They create 100% organic compost, soils and seedling mixes.

Return and Earn Recycling: Over 8 billion containers have been returned, delivering \$800 million in refunds to the people of NSW, and drink container litter has reduced by a massive 52 per cent.


Water Saving: The Club utilises water efficient glasswashers, saves water using solar and has two water tanks under our facility that catch water from the roof, used to flush the toilets.

Small but significant changes

- LED Lighting using less energy
- Promotional Screens to save paper
- Cardboard Recycling via Yumaro
- Toner Recycling
- Glass and Aluminium Recycling via Cleanaway
- Uniform recycling via Textile Recycling at the Ulladulla Waste Depot
- Membership and Effpos Card recycling via Biome
- No single use plastic

Safe Waters is a local not for profit organisation that fights against homelessness in our area and provides a safe place to sleep.


